Magnet has been instrumental in facillitating access to the University of Cape Town for 32 first generation university attendees. 17 have graduated, 3 with post-graduate qualifications; and 11 are still studying.

63% of our graduates are actively employed in the creative industry. A further 6% are employed fulltime in the broader economy bringing the employment rate of graduates to 69%.

56% of the graduates shared their skills, teaching school learners and young adults in community centres, high schools, tertiary institutions, and professional theatres.


